PARTY IDEAS

- 1. Create a "Sign my book" online button for people to share on social media.
- 2. Use backstage passes:
 - Lanyards
 - Stickers
 - · Leverage existing Staff Press Passes
- 3. Have extra autograph supplements available to purchase at the event.
- 4. Rent a photo booth for the party or have your staff available to take party pics.
- 5. Ask a local FM radio DJ to hold a remote at the party or DJ the party. If you can't afford a DJ or can't find one to host, make a playlist and have a student volunteer to DJ with a bluetooth speaker.
- 6. Get removable sticky notes that say "Reserved" so students can reserve a section of their book for a particular person to sign.
- 7. Ask your school mascot to come to the party.
- 8. Create Golden Tickets to include in a set number of yearbooks and promote this in advance. Winners receive a prize.
- 9. Have your staff create a poster of celebrity yearbook photos and encourage students to guess each star.
- 10. Order plenty of wristbands to give to each student as they enter the event. Wristbands are great way to monitor re-entry and are available at walsworthyearbooks.com/bigevent.
- 11. Coordinate with local food trucks to be on site for the Big Event good food always draws a crowd!
